

MCGA Tee Box Committee Recommendations (11/22/2021)

We as a tee box/handicap committee met and have the following recommendations.

Implement a manual handicap adjustment system for playing different tees during MCGA events. The adjustments would be made during score entry with the software at the end of the round. The adjustments would be based on differences in the course ratings of the tees that are suggested by the USGA / WHS.

After additional investigation, we recommend the addition of a new tee box for men called "Super Senior." Men aged 75 and older would be eligible to move up two tee boxes from standard tee, if that tee area is available and has a proper course rating. Players choosing to play from the Super Senior tee would be subject to proper handicap adjustment described above.

We recommend the reduction of the handicap eligibility to play the forward tees by players with a standard tee handicap of 23 back to the previous requirement of 20. The higher handicap eligibility was intended to take the place of a handicap adjustment, and is no longer needed.
